The Danish Ministry of Economic and Business Affairs have published a Market Notice regarding the Governmental Guarantee Scheme established by Act no. 1003 of 10 October 2008 on Financial Stability.

Under the scheme, a creditor, or a representative of a creditor, who does not receive payment of a valid claim from a bank covered by the scheme may notify the Danish Financial Supervisory Authority.

The Danish Financial Supervisory Authority (the "Danish FSA") shall receive the following information from any creditor notifying a claim pursuant to the Governmental Guarantee Scheme:

1. information about the creditor, bank account details, and contact information, including on any representative in Denmark;
2. detailed information regarding the claim, including name of debtor, amount, currency and date of maturity;
3. original or certified copies of the loan agreement and/or other documentation evidencing the claim;
4. the name and contact details of a person, the Danish FSA or the Winding-Up Company may contact.

All information should be in Danish, Norwegian, Swedish or English.
