## Dmitry Vasiliev: we have transferred materials on the Ministry of Finance and the Central Bank to the Prosecutor General's Office

### Summary

Scandal after scandal has flared up around FCSM Chairman Dmitry Vasiliev in recent days. After Prime Minister Yevgeny Primakov rejected his resignation two weeks ago, the head of the Federal Commission had a serious quarrel with the Bank of Russia, the Finance Ministry and the Moscow Interbank Currency Exchange, which he banned from trading shares. Dmitry Vasiliev spoke about the causes of these conflicts in an interview with a Kommersant correspondent, Peter Rushailo.
