Ecuador's Central Bank Pegs Bank Withdrawals At 1.7 Billion Sucres

Amid the growing nervousness triggered after the government declared a partial freeze on bank deposits, Ecuadoreans have withdrawn about 1.7 billion sucres (\$1=ECS10,050) from banks, Central Bank President Luis Jacome said Tuesday.
