Lombard loans no more

Summary

Yesterday, the Central Bank of Russia (CBR) stopped offering banks Lombard loans at a fixed interest rate. Now it will only be possible to borrow money from the CBR secured by government bonds at weekly credit auctions and for no more than seven days. According to bankers, this may lead to another fall in prices for GKO's.
