David Cameron Told Sunak Excluding Greensill Would Be ‘Nuts’

Summary

This investigative article describes the communications between former British Prime Minister David Cameron and current Chancellor of the Exchequer Rishi Sunak. Cameron attempted to lobby officials at the Bank of England and Her Majesty’s Treasury to allow Greensill Capital, a supply-chain finance company, to participate in various support programs launched by the British government in response to the COVID-19 crisis in 2020. The article describes communications between Cameron and Sunak, and it covers actions taken by the House of Commons Treasury Committee through their formal inquiry.
