Summary

The article says that China, which is pushing to end the dominance of the dollar as a worldwide reserve, has agreed a Rmb70bn (\$10.24bn, £7.18bn, €7.76bn) currency swap with Argentina that will allow it to receive renminbi instead of dollars for its exports to the Latin American country.
